Admissions

General Admissions Requirements

1. Government issued ID and student visa.
2. The applicant must be 18 years of age. If the applicant is less than 18 years of age, a parent's guardian signature is required to enroll the student in the program.
3. Complete the VERSANT placement test in order to place the student in a proper ESL.
4. In addition to the VERSANT, the student meets with the ESL instructor for an oral evaluation.
5. Submit a completed and signed Application for Admission and be present for an entrance interview.

International Students

Student Visa Requirements:

1. Applicants must prove that sufficient funds are available from source to defray all living and school expenses during the entire period of study in the United States. The last three bank statements of the sponsor or the student must be presented along with a letter from the sponsor or student
2. Present to school a photocopy of passport and I-20 if applicable.

3. Persons applying for F-1 visa with the initial I-20 will require payment of SEVIS fee of \$200. The check or money order should be made payable to the US Department of Homeland Security.
4. Make a processing fee payment.
5. Students who wish to extend their F-1 status, must present bank statements to the school in order to be granted extension. Extension will be granted only if students are in good academic and financial standing with ULI.

Student Visa Requirements:

2. Present to school a photocopy of passport and I-20 if applicable

4. Make a first payment of \$400.00 as processing fee applying towards tuition
5. Students who wish to extend their F-1 status will be granted extension only if they are in good academic and financial standing with ULI.

Additional Enrollment Options & Fees

Students who are traveling to the United States for tourism or for a temporary amount of time can enroll in ULI's ESL program on a weekly basis. ULI's curriculum and schedule is based on two-week and three-week intervals over a ten-week academic quarter. This means that any student can jump in and out of any level at any two-to-three-week intervals. Throughout any chosen session, students will be guaranteed dynamic courses in grammar, conversation, pronunciation and listening/response, among other disciplines. Students may choose to enroll in courses for as little as two weeks or the complete ten-week session. All classes are a part of our dually accredited ESL program, which has been developing students' English and American cultural comprehension for more than 15 years.

1-3 weeks = \$300 per week

4-8 weeks = \$250 per week

8 & up = \$199 per week
